**MOTION TO TERMINATE ENFORCEMENT OF
INCOME DEDUCTION ORDER**

I am filing this motion under OCGA §19-6-33(f) to ask the Court to stop enforcement of the Income Deduction Order (“IDO”) in this case. I support my motion as follows:

1.

My name is _____ and I am the obligor under the IDO in this case.

2.

The IDO was entered on _____ to enforce payment of child support in this case.

3.

According to the child support order, the duty to pay child support has ended. But, my employer continues to deduct the child support payments from my wages because of the IDO. My employer requires a court order to stop enforcement of the IDO.

4.

The child support order required me to pay child support for the following time period:

(a) **Beyond Age 18 for High School** - The child support shall continue until each child reaches the age of eighteen, dies, marries, or otherwise becomes emancipated; provided that if a child becomes eighteen years old while enrolled in and attending secondary school on a full-time basis, then the child support shall continue for the child until the child has graduated from secondary school or reaches twenty years of age, whichever occurs first.

(b) **Stops at Age 18** - The child support shall continue monthly thereafter until each child reaches the age of eighteen, dies, marries, or otherwise becomes emancipated.

The following children were covered by the child support order in this case:

I do not owe any child support arrearage for these children.

Therefore, under the terms of the child support order in this case, the amount of support I am obligated to pay is zero, and the IDO should be stopped so that my employer will stop withholding the child support from my income.

THEREFORE, I ask the Court to enter an order terminating enforcement of the Income Deduction Order in this case.
